Ensure Affordable Coverage and Access	<ol> <li>Ensure that people with pre-existing, chronic conditions have access to affordable insurance that covers their needed products and services with appropriate subsidies for the financially disadvantaged</li> <li>Create appropriate mechanisms to pool and spread insurance risk across broad groups of people to promote affordability and stability of premiums and ensure access for high-risk people with chronic conditions</li> <li>Ensure affordable and predictable out-of-pocket costs</li> <li>Remove unnecessary barriers to access such as utilization management that rely on the use of population averages</li> </ol>
Promote Access to High- Value Care, as Defined by Patients	<ol> <li>Ensure costs for health care products and services align with value, as defined by patients</li> <li>Encourage care coordination, adherence, and disease management</li> <li>Encourage health promotion and prevention</li> <li>Reward providers for efficiency and effectiveness on the basis of outcomes that matter to patients</li> <li>Provide patients with adequate and transparent options for comprehensive and appropriate coverage and care</li> </ol>
Promote Health System Sustainability	<ol> <li>Promote solutions that view total health care cost over the long term, rather than short term</li> <li>Finance innovative treatments through novel solutions that spread the costs over longer periods of time</li> <li>Ensure that the health care system can meet the needs of all people as access is expanded</li> <li>Promote the spread of health care financial liability so that the entire burden is not placed on a single entity</li> </ol>
