## 2021 Dues Schedule Business & Industry and Associate Members

Created by and for patient organizations 100 years ago, the National Health Council (NHC) brings diverse organizations together to forge consensus and drive patient-centered health policy. We promote increased access to affordable, high-value, sustainable health care.

Made up of more than 140 national health- related organizations and businesses, the NHC’s core membership includes the nation’s leading patient organizations. Other members include health-related associations and nonprofit organizations including the provider, research, and family caregiver communities, and businesses representing biopharmaceutical, device, diagnostic, generic drug, and payer organizations.

Dues are a vital source of income to the NHC, allowing us to continue bringing together diverse patient advocacy groups to provide a united voice for the 160 million people living with chronic diseases and disabilities and their family caregivers. Dues are for the calendar year based on total national revenue as listed on the most recent financial filings. First-year dues will be prorated from the date that the NHC’s Board of Directors approves the member’s application.

**Business and Industry** - Business and Industry members are for-profit companies engaged in the sale of health- related products or services, such as pharmaceutical, generic drug, insurance, biotechnology, and medical device companies. This category includes any subsidiaries or related entities, such as foundations, affiliated with an organization that would otherwise be classified as a business and industry member.

**Associate** - Associate members are organizations that are considered to be primarily vendors. Associate members have all member privileges, except they are not invited to be represented on the NHC’s Board of Directors or Nominating Committee, and cannot vote at meetings of the entire membership.
