

## Current Dues Schedule Business & Industry Members

Created by and for patient organizations over 100 years ago, the National Health Council (NHC) brings diverse organizations together to forge consensus and drive patientcentered health policy. We promote increased access to affordable, high-value, sustainable, equitable health care.

Made up of more than 160 national health-related organizations and businesses, the NHC's core membership includes the nation's leading patient organizations. Other members include health-related associations and nonprofit organizations including the provider, research, and family caregiver communities, and businesses representing biopharmaceutical, device, diagnostic, generic drug, and payer organizations.

Dues are a vital source of income for the NHC, allowing us to meet our mission of providing a united voice for the 160 million people living with chronic diseases and disabilities and their family caregivers. Dues are for the calendar year and based on total national revenue as listed on a member's most recent financial filings. First-year dues will be prorated from the date that the NHC's Board of Directors approves the member's application.

**Business and Industry -** Business and Industry members share a focus on providing goods, services, and knowledge that are disseminated through the health ecosystem to aid in the treatment and management of chronic conditions and disabilities. Also included in this category are nonprofit associations that represent the business interests of certain sectors within the health ecosystem.

\*The dues rates will be reviewed annually for inflation adjustments and bi-annually for other rate adjustments.

\*\*The rate name "emerging" replaces the former language of "without a marketed product". Emerging B&I companies are bringing new and innovative ideas to the health care space but have not established a revenue stream and begun generating revenue. Once they are established in the sector, the expectation is for these members to convert to full Business members.

\*\*\*Associate members are interested and committed to the NHC mission while exploring their role within the NHC community. Members will be invited to stay in this rate category for a maximum of three years, and then they must convert to the full rate. Members currently in this category are grandfathered in and may stay at this rate until the 2027 renewal cycle.

\*\*\*\*Starting in 2024, Nonprofit Health Sector Trade Groups will now fall under the Business and Industry category.

\*\*\*\*\*This dues rate will be used for Nonprofit Health Sector Trade Groups whose annual revenue is under \$20 million.
