Medicare changes for 2025 could impact the plan you or your loved ones choose.

Next year, Medicare will limit everyone's total out-of-pocket drug costs to \$2,000 a year and introduce the Medicare Prescription Payment Plan, a new option to spread drug costs over the year, instead of paying upfront.

THIS HELPS PEOPLE WITH:

- · High-cost drugs and chronic conditions
- · Unexpected drug expenses during the year
- Budgeting and predicting costs

HOW IT WORKS:

- Medicare automatically applies the \$2,000 annual limit.
- You can opt-in to the monthly payment option through your plan at any time for no additional cost.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Who is eligible? Everyone with a Medicare prescription drug plan or a Medicare Advantage drug plan.

Do the changes lower my costs? Those who currently pay more than \$2,000 a year will automatically save money. The option to spread out costs over the year will not change overall spending but can make budgeting your prescriptions more manageable.

How will this work with my existing
Medicare plan? After evaluating and choosing
the right plan for you on Medicare.gov, you can
opt in to monthly payments through your plan
or decide you don't need to make any changes.
