



Liver Cancers Stats



By 2040, WHO estimates

1.4 million new cases of liver cancers annually

1.3 million deaths from liver cancers annually

70% of cases of liver cancer are preventable with available knowledge and technology

HCC risk factors

HBV 44%

Alcohol 26%

HCV 21%

Smoking 13%

Obesity 9%

Diabetes 7%

Aflatoxin 4.6-28.2%

Global Burden of Liver Cancers

Males 65+ have the highest rate of liver cancer

Hispanics have the highest incidence

Al/AN mortality rate of is highest

Liver cancer is the 6th most common cancer, and the 3rd deadliest cancer in the world





Estimated number of new cases (in millions)

Campaign Goals

- Raise awareness of liver cancer prevention, treatment, and survivorship by elevating the liver cancer discourse through conversations with trailblazing panelists of diverse disciplines
- 1. Increase collaborations with health organizations that serve under-resourced communities that bear the burden of disproportionate liver cancer rates
- 1. Enhance health literacy of vulnerable communities by translating liver cancer resources to Japanese and Vietnamese
- 1. Strengthen global public awareness of chronic diseases, including viral hepatitis and cirrhosis, that increase the risk for liver cancer


