2026 NHC Washington Representative Meetings

The National Health Council recognizes that meaningful change for patients is driven through legislative and regulatory advocacy. As part of its mission, NHC convenes experts and patient advocates twice a year to inform policy discussions and advance solutions that reflect patient needs.

The **Washington Representatives Summer Meeting (WRSM)** brings together government relations and policy professionals from NHC member patient advocacy and health nonprofit organizations. In this half-day meeting, attendees hear from Congressional staff on key issues affecting the patient community and connect with peers to discuss advocacy strategies for the 119th Congress. The meeting will be held **June 15, 2026 in Washington, DC**.

The **Washington Representatives Retreat (WRR)** convenes senior government relations and public policy leaders from patient advocacy and health care organizations to discuss pressing health policy issues. Participants also provide input to NHC on policy priorities and strategies for the coming year. The agenda and speakers are guided by a member planning committee. The **2025 retreat will take place November 19-20, 2026 in Annapolis, MD**.
